Daily Ramadan Checklist.

Proofs from the Qur'an and the sunnah:

1. Aisha ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: "Fajr prayer is better than the world and everything in it."
2. Jandab Bin Saifan narrated that the prophet (s) said: "Whoever prays the morning prayer he is with Allah (s), so look Oh son of Adam do not let yourself be indebted to Allah (s).
3. "Say thanks to your lord before the sun rises and before it sets."
4. Abi Hurrara ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: "Whoever says Subhanna Allah after every prayer 33 times, Allhamdulillah 33 times, and Allahu Akbar 33 times, and then until he reaches 100: La illaha ila Allah wahdahu la sharika la, lahu al Mulk wa lahu Alhamd wa howa alla kul shay' kadir, his sins will be forgiven even if they were as great as the ocean."
5. Abi Thar ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: " Each morning you are required to give a charity for each joint of your body. So each praise of Allah is a charity, and ordering what is good is a charity, and forbidding what is evil is a charity, and praying two raqaa' after sunrise (Duha) is enough to cover all of this.
6. Aisha ® has said of the prophet (s): "He would pray at home before Dhuhur 4 rakaat, then he would go the masjid and pray with the people, then he would come home and pray 2 rakaat, then he would go again to pray maghrib with the people, then he would come home and pray 2 rakaat, then he would go again to pray Isha with the people, then he would come home and pray 2 rakaat."
7. Jabir ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: " The 5 prayers are like a river that is running to your door for you to wash in 5 times a day."
8. Ib Umar ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: "The group prayer (jamaa') is better than prayer alone by 27 deeds."
9. Ib Masud ® has said: "I asked the prophet (s): what are the best actions? He said: Prayer on time. "Then what?" I asked. "Obeying your parents" he replied. "Then what?" I asked again. "Jihad for the sake of Allah (s)."
10. Uthman bin Affan ® said: "I heard the prophet (s) saying: "Any Muslim who comes upon a prayer should perfect it's wudu, and it's humbleness, and it's ruquu', it will do nothing but erase all bad sins before it, except for the major sins."
11. Aly ® said: The Witr prayer is not like the obligatory prayer, however the prophet (s) said that the Allah (s) is one and he likes the odd numbered prayers (witr) so do your witr prayer oh people of the Qur'an."
12. Abi Umamah ® said: "I heard the prophet (s) say: "Read the Qur'an for it will intercede to its friends on the Day of Judgment.
13. Uthman bin Affan ® narrated that the prophet (s) said: " The best of you is him who learns the Qur'an and then teaches it."
14. Abi Umamah ® said: "A man asked the prophet (s): what is the most answerable duaa? The prophet replied: During the last part of the night and after the written prayers.
15. Abi Huraira ® said: "I heard the prophet (s) say: "I swear to god that I ask forgiveness of him, and submit to him over 70 times in one day."
16. Abi Hurrara ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: "Whoever prays qiyam during Ramadan with faith and hope all his sins from before will be forgiven."
17. Ib Abbas said: "The prophet (s) was the most generous of people, and he was even more generous during Ramadan."
18. Abi Said AlKhudri ® narrated that the prophet (s) has said: "The Suhoor is a blessing. Don't leave it even if you take just a sip of water because Allah (s) and his angels pray for the people who eat suhoor."
19. Abi Harira ® said that the prophet (s) said: "Whoever fasts Ramadan with faith and hope, all of his past sins will be forgiven."
